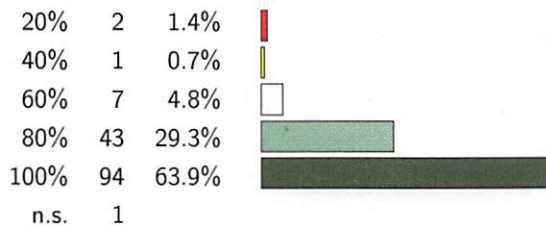
The evaluation is based on 148 questionnaires, type of course: Lecture

The course has extended my abilities.

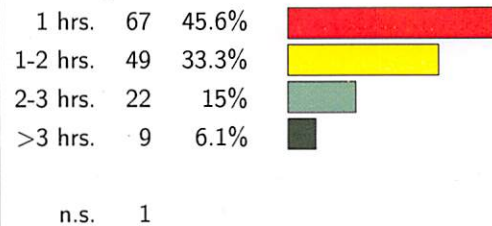

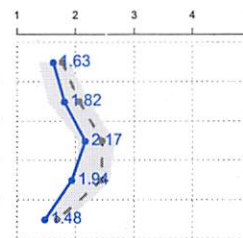

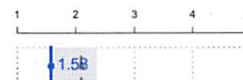
