The internship requires you to have obtained a Bachelor degree in an empirical social science (e.g., economics, psychology, sociology), good methodological knowledge, and excellent verbal and written English. Programming skills and prior research experience are welcome but not essential.

In your application, please include a short cover letter describing your background and motivation, your CV, and PDF copies of supporting materials. Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled.

The internship can be no shorter than two months and depending on whether the internship is completed full time or part time, you are paid €380 or €190 per month, respectively.
