Call for Papers

The CR Berlin Study Group will host a one day paper development workshop at FU Berlin.

<u>Aims</u>

Since its inaugural meeting in March 2011, the CR Berlin study group has emerged as an important forum bringing together Berlin scholars on corporate responsibility from a variety of disciplines. The study group has worked in various formats including hosting international guests, paper presentations, "world café" sessions to explore collaborations among group members, round table debates with practitioners and open discussion forums on cutting edge issues in Corporate Responsibility research.

This 2nd paper development workshop aims to deepen this interdisciplinary dialogue around the research on Corporate Responsibility between management and organization theory, accounting, political economy, economic sociology, business ethics, and other fields. The workshop will be focused on the presentation and development of papers intended for journal publication and their discussion.

Those interested in presenting a paper should submit a title and abstract (no more than one page) by the date below. Submissions should be limited to unpublished papers, although papers under review or undergoing a revise and resubmit are very welcome. Upon acceptance, full papers will be submitted and made available in advance of the workshop. Paper presentations by the author will be limited to 20 minutes followed by comments from a discussant (roughly 10 minutes) and then open discussion.
