# CR Berlin Study Group 3rd Paper Development Workshop

#### **Call for Papers**

Once again, the CR Berlin Study Group will be hosting a one day paper development workshop at the FU Berlin.

Since its inaugural meeting in March 2011, the CR Berlin study group has brought together Berlin scholars from a variety of disciplines to discuss about corporate responsibility.

This 3<sup>rd</sup> paper development workshop aims to deepen this interdisciplinary dialogue around the re-search on Corporate Responsibility between management and organization theory, accounting, political economy, economic sociology, business ethics, and other fields.

The workshop will allow discussion and development of research in two formats:

- 1. **Research papers** intended for journal publication. Paper presentations by the author will be limited to 20 minutes followed by comments from a discussant (roughly 10 minutes) and open discussion. 45 minutes total.
- 2. Project / PhD proposals for future work at the earlier planning stages. Presentations should be limited to 10 minutes followed by discussant comments and Q&A. 30 minutes total.

Those interested in presenting a paper or project should submit a title and abstract (no more than one page) by the date below, indicating whether the submission is a paper or project proposal. Upon acceptance, full papers or proposals should be made available in advance of the workshop.
