UNDERGRADUATE (Bachelor): <ul style="list-style-type: none">• B1 Italian level required for courses taught in Italian;• B1 level for courses taught in English (the didactical offer in English at Bachelor level is restricted) GRADUATE (Master): <ul style="list-style-type: none">• B2 Italian level for courses taught in Italian;• B2 level for courses taught in English; The language requirement is mandatory for the admission and has to be uploaded in the online application form. For this purpose we can accept certificates internationally |

| Language of tuition | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Courses at <u>Bachelor level</u>: taught mainly in Italian; only a few courses are offered in English. The Department of Economics offers some “English-friendly courses”, which means courses taught in Italian with the possibility of sitting the exam in English (with materials in English). • Courses at <u>Master level</u>: taught in English (4 Master’s Degrees entirely taught in English) and taught in Italian (4 Master’s Degrees taught in Italian). Also at Master level the Department of Economics offers some “English-friendly courses”, which means courses taught in Italian with the possibility of sitting the exam in English (with materials in English). |
