2.4 Additional requirements

Partner universities must have previously signed a bilateral agreement with UIC, and must select and officially nominate students for academic exchange who have passed all first-year subjects and who are able and willing to:

- Abide by UIC's academic calendar, rules, & regulations;
- Comply with applicable visa/immigration policies & local laws;
- Ensure complete medical coverage for their entire stay at UIC;
- Have a sufficient level of Spanish to take courses and exams in Spanish (where specified)
- Health Sciences students should provide immunization records

Completed applications/information on nominated students must reach our institution by:

Autumn term – (1st SEM) (September to December)	15 th June
Spring term – (2nd SEM) (January to June)	15 th November
