2 Doctoral Positions

The chair for empirical economics offers two doctoral positions starting Oct.1, 2019 or before. The salary corresponds to a 75 % position TV-L E13 on the pay scale (for details see e.g. oeffentlicher-dienst.info).

One position is entrusted with the management of the Bavarian Graduate Program in Economics (www.bgpe.de) the other involves the general tasks of a doctoral student. Both positions facilitate independent research leading to a dissertation supported by the chair.
